Dear Mr. Scott:

As you know, the FRCC Regional Projects Subcommittee (RPS) will be working with an independent consultant to conduct a technical analysis for the purpose of validating CEERTS project information and analysis provided by Florida Power & Light (FPL) under “Step 3” of the FRCC 2017-2018 Biennial Transmission Planning Process (BTPP). FPL has submitted six project alternatives that may displace four (4) Duke Energy Florida (DEF) planned projects within the current FRCC Board-approved Regional Plan.<sup>1</sup> The DEF impacted projects are listed below:

- 1) DEF’s Osprey to Kathleen and Osprey to Haines City East 230 kV transmission line
- 2) DEF’s Bronson to Williston 230 kV transmission line
- 3) DEF’s Crystal River to Bronson 230 kV transmission line rebuild, and
- 4) DEF’s new Williston 230/69 kV substation

The FRCC Planning Committee (PC) requests that DEF submit any information regarding the DEF projects above to the PC, so the PC can provide that information to the independent consultant for the purposes of informing and aiding the technical evaluation process under Step 3 of the BTPP.

Provision of this information is entirely voluntary. Should DEF decide to provide additional information, the PC requests that it be provided by August 14, 2017. Any information received will be reviewed during a subsequent special open stakeholder PC meeting prior to submittal to the independent consultant.
